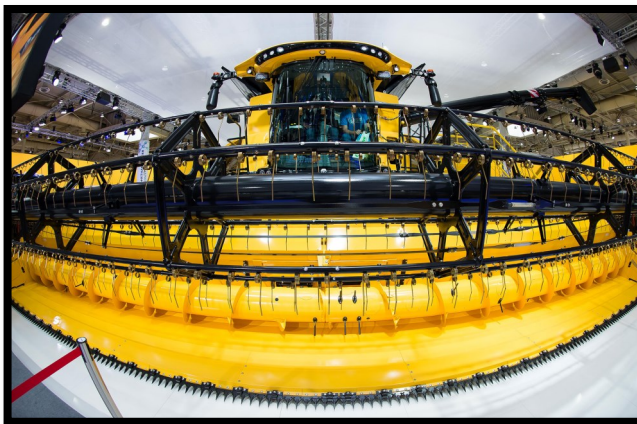

**AGRITECHNICA is now the world's leading trade fair for agricultural machinery!**  
**AGRITECHNICA 2023 was attended by 2,897 exhibitors from 47 countries, including all the world market leaders.**

**Altogether 1,513 of these exhibitors came from outside Germany.**

**The trade fair was divided into sector groups in 24 halls covering a floor space of over 100 acres and its nearly 200 forum events and specialist conferences allowed a unique exchange of information and opinions. The trade fair attracted around 450,000 visitors from 88 countries, including 106,700 international visitors.**

In the morning you will go to go to visit **CLAAS Factory Harsewinkel** (\*to be confirmed) Combines have been manufactured here in the main CLAAS factory since 1936. To the present day, over 400,000 machines have been built. Since the restructuring of the factory, which was completed in 2003, Harsewinkel is one of the most high-tech production plants of combines and agricultural choppers in the world.
